CRITERIA: JUNIOR AVICULTURALIST

It is in the interest of our club and aviculture as a whole to encourage members of younger generations to become interested in and partake in aviculture.

Entry cost into aviculture is restrictive and to this end the CACADU AVICULTURE ASSOCIATION has undertaken to assist selected youth into bird keeping.

To avoid any potential confusion or misunderstandings the following criteria is to be used as a basic framework of the program.

Criteria/Conditions:

Selection of potential candidates is to be the sole responsibility of the committee

Club members may motivate potential candidates to the committee.

Committee to ensure candidate has support of parents

Committee to ensure maximum success rate by allocating mentor/s to the selected candidate

Mentors to provide regular update/feedback at committee meetings

Committee to source materials to assist selected candidates. Materials may include for example birds, aviary materials or any equipment that can be used.

Candidates to receive free club membership until such time as they are employed/able to afford club fees.

The committee may invite potential candidates to complete a project in form of application for assistance.
